Biographical Addendum

Claire M. Fagin, R.N., Ph.D., F.A.A.N., has participated in nursing as a practitioner, researcher, educator, author, administrator, policy maker and advisor in both the public and private sectors. She has been a vibrant force in propelling nursing into the twenty-first century.

During her career she served as dean of the School of Nursing, University of Pennsylvania from 1972 to 1991. In 1991-92 she served as Interim President of the University of Pennsylvania—the first woman to hold the title of interim president at any Ivy League university. In 1992 she retired from the University. She has continued to serve as Dean Emeritus and Leadership Professor Emeritus.

Dr. Fagin is the author of ten books and monographs and has contributed more than seventy-five articles to professional journals. Her first book, *Family-Centered Nursing in Community Psychiatry: Treatment in the Home*, incorporating her landmark dissertation research in psychiatric nursing, appeared in 1970. The study was instrumental in loosening hospital rules limiting parental stays with hospitalized children. During the 1980s and 1990s, Dr. Fagin explored broad policy issues in health care such as cost effectiveness in care delivery and the need for nursing home reform. In 1994-95, under a grant from The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, she was the principal investigator on a study of the Nursing Home Reform Act of 1987--part of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1987, or OBRA 87. The study investigated OBRA87's efforts to set standards with regard to resident rights for privacy, security, nutrition, and health.

In 1996 she co-edited the proceedings of a conference held at the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing entitled *Abandonment of the Patient: The Impact of Profit-Driven Health Care on the Public*. The most recent of her book-length publications include *Essays on Nursing Leadership* (2000), a selection of readings in which she discusses many of the issues facing health care in which nurses can play a leadership role.

Dr. Fagin has served on corporate boards and has held numerous elected and appointed positions in professional organizations. These have included the Board of Directors of CMAC, Inc.; the New York Academy of Medicine; and the van Ameringer Foundation. She was a member of the Institute of Medicine, the Expert Panel on Nursing of the World Health Organization, and the American Academy of Arts and Science. Her roles on nursing association committees have been legion. During the 1990s she sat on the Tri-Council for Nursing, comprised of the chief elected and executive officers of the American Association of Colleges of Nursing, American Nurses' Association, American Organization of Nurse Executives, and the National League for Nursing.

She has received ten honorary doctoral degrees and numerous alumni, civic, and professional awards. In recognition of her contribution to nursing education and leadership and her influence on health care policy, Dr. Fagin received the Honorary Recognition Award of the American Nurses' Association--the most prestigious honor awarded in the nursing profession. In 1998 she was designated a "Living Legend" by the American Academy of Nursing. She lives in New York City and continues to research and consult with foundations in the field of health care.

Recent Accretion to the Claire Fagin Papers, 1976-2000

The papers described below are an addendum to the papers of Claire M. Fagin, 1926-1996 (16.3 linear feet) which Dr. Fagin donated to the Center for the Study of History of Nursing, School of Nursing, University of Pennsylvania, in 1990. Researchers are advised to consult the finding aids for each segment of the Fagin holdings because of occasional overlaps in the subject matter. By and large the material in the recent accession, received in July 2000, deals with Dr. Fagin's post-retirement years since 1992. However, there are notable exceptions such as bodies of material dealing with Claire Fagin's career as a faculty member and dean of the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing (see Series III). The materials in the accretion have been arranged in series groupings which are similar to those used in the earlier papers.
