Biographical Sketch. Sara Cecelia Mailer Erricicson was born in Long Branch, New Jersey in 1907. She attended the Monmouth Memorial Hospital School of Nursing in 1925, and received a Bachelor's of Science in Nursing degree from Seton Hall University in 1946. From 1928-1936 she worked as a staff nurse and assistant supervisor at Long Branch Public Health Nursing Association. Her public health nursing career started in 1936 when she became supervisor at the Monmouth County Local Health Unit #2. From 1942-1952, she held various positions at the Monmouth County Organization for Social Service, the New Jersey State Department of Health, and the Nursing Home and Chronic Disease Hospital, in Long Island. She joined the New Jersey State Nurses Association in 1953 and worked there as associate executive director, director, and editor. She retired in 1979.

Summary. This collections, constituting .8 linear feet includes personal files as well as files relating to organizations that Errickson was active in. The vast majority of this collection is composed of xeroxecl copies of the original documents held by Erricicson.
