The Leonard A. Lauder Community Care Nurse Practitioner Program at Penn Nursing was announced in February 2022 as a first-of-its-kind, tuition-free program dedicated to developing a nurse practitioner workforce committed to working in and with underserved communities, both rural and urban. The Leonard A. Lauder program was borne out of a \$125 million gift—the largest ever to an American nursing school—by Penn alumnus Leonard A. Lauder, chairman emeritus of the Estée Lauder Companies. Through this program, Penn Nursing's leadership in primary care will continue to grow, as will its partnerships with community-based health agencies.
