**In addition to STAT 101 & 102, Wharton Business Fundamentals include ACCT 101, ACCT 102, BEPP 250, FNCE 100, FNCE 101, MGMT 101, MKTG 101, OPIM 101. Students progress through these courses in a variety of different ways depending on their own strengths and interests. Consult with an advisor to develop the pathway that fits best for you.

All plans of study are subject to curricular change. Students must consult with an academic advisor prior to making revisions to the plan of study to ensure the necessary curricular requirements are being met and to prevent delays in academic progression. Also, please note that this is just one example of how a student can progress through the NHCM curriculum. There are a number of ways to customize this to individual student interests and needs, including when to begin the nursing clinical sequence, how and when to start the HCMG concentration, etc. Meet with an advisor early and often to discuss your individual path.
