Dear Member of the School of Nursing Class of 2022,

As your attention shifts from proms and graduation to roommates, dorm rooms and course selection, we wanted to share with you some information on the fall semester first year School of Nursing chemistry course.

The School of Nursing offers a fourteen week general chemistry course titled: *Biologically Based Chemistry* (NURS 061). This course is required for all first year Nursing students. However, you are exempted from the NURS 061 Chemistry course if you received a grade of 700 or higher on the SAT II Chemistry exam or a score of "5" on the AP Chemistry exam.

Students in NURS 061 will also need a scientific calculator for calculations including logs and square roots. These calculators are not expensive. They cost between \$10 and \$20.

**Programmable calculators cannot be used during the chemistry exams.**
